JAMCOM Team Member

### Reporting to:

JAMCOM Team Leader

### Role Description:

JAMCOM Team Members are responsible for the receiving, sending and logging of all radio / telecoms messages into JAMCOM and out to the relevant recipient.

Main duties include;

- To contribute to a 24/7 team rota of JAMCOM operators.
- To staff the JAMCOM control room and coordinate and record all inbound and outbound communications traffic among all parties within KIJ
- To escalate matters of concern received via radio
- To utilise technology such as mobile radios, lap top PCs and telephone devices.
- To support the provision of radio communications equipment to colleagues
- To comply with the relevant policy with regards to issue and use of radio communications equipment
- To comply with relevant JAMCOM, KIJ and TSA policy as directed
- To maintain accurate daily logs of issued radios and equipment.
- To provide JAMCOM support, working alongside side the Silver Manager in the event of a significant incident

### Essential Requirements:

- A member of either the Scout or Guiding Associations, or a willingness to join either
- Be over 18





- Hold a current DBS check and ensure it is valid for the event. (DBS number will be required)
- Can organise, manage and communicate in a consistent, professional manner
- Hold a Scout / Guide First Aid qualification
- Be friendly, welcoming and have a personable approach
- Be willing to work at obscure times and unsociable hours – shift work is required for this role due to 24hr cover
- Able to make effective decisions and operate under pressure
- Confident in managing a team

#### **Non-Essential Requirements:**

- Have experience of jamboree teams or similar either inside or outside of Scouting/Guiding; however, this is not essential
