Role Title:

JamCOM Technical Manager

Reporting to:

Head of Operations

Role Description:

Responsible for;

- Technical management of site infrastructure including telecoms and secure IP access
- Overall management of the Jamcom operations centre team

The main activities/duties of this role include;

- Installation and maintenance of a suitable IP telephony system
- Installation and maintenance of a suitable CCTV system
- Management of Radio infrastructure
- Management of Jamcom ops room equipment including computers, servers and similar
- Provision of a resilient incident tracking platform
- Providing cover for Ops Manager and/or Silver Managers as and when required
- Providing cover for Ops centre team where required

Essential Requirements:

- A member of either the Scout or Guiding Associations, or a willingness to join either
- Hold a current DBS check and ensure it is valid for the event. (DBS number will be required)
- Have a comprehensive understanding of TSA POR relevant to events such as this
- Have technical knowledge required to support the relevant infrastructure





- Be willing to work at obscure times and unsociable hours – shift work is required for this role due to 24hr cover.
- Have experience of jamboree teams or similar either inside or outside of Scouting; however, this is not essential
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- IT literate
- Experience in dealing with external partners e.g. press and media, police, NHS
- Able to make decisions swiftly and effectively and operate under pressure
- Able to delegate effectively
- Able to work well within and across teams
- Be up to date with relevant Scout Training modules as defined by role

- Have experience of jamboree teams or similar either inside or outside of Scouting/Guiding.
