Deputy Programme & Training Manager

### **Reporting to:**

Programme & Training Manager and Hub Team

### **Role Description:**

Supporting the Programme & Training Manager in leading the teams at the Training and Programme Hubs. Working as part of the 'The Hub' - the adult zone of the Jamboree - you will help lead, manage and deliver this aspect of adult programme for those attending the Jamboree. The Programme and Training Hubs will allow and enable leaders and volunteers to access a programme of activities aimed at them during their downtime, gain programme ideas to take away to run in their sections, and access modules from both organisations' training schemes as well as other appropriate training.

### **Essential Requirements:**

The ability to lead volunteers and work as part of a wider team is exceptionally important. You will be familiar with the requirements (and changing requirements) of Scout and/or Guide training schemes and programme aims. You will be used to project planning and dealing with large amounts of information; scheduling and facilitating a range of training and programme activities is a central requirement.

### **Nice to haves:**

Previous experience of working at larger events and particularly in an administrative role will help. Connections with trainers and programme ideas to enable delivery will be exceptionally useful.
