Role Description:

Working as part of the 'The Hub' - the adult zone of the Jamboree - you will help deliver a range of programme activities to adults attending the Jamboree. These will include "programme in a box" style activities that can be taken away to be delivered at sections post the Jamboree, as well as programme activities that adults can take part in during their downtime. The Programme Hub will be a central part of 'The Hub' and offer adults a chance to network and relax when they are not on rota or required to support their Group. The Programme Hub will form a key part of the post Jamboree legacy as adults take ideas and inspiration away to their sections.

Essential Requirements:

The ability to work as part of a wider team is exceptionally important. You will be creative with programme ideas and familiar with the programme aims of the Scout/Guide organisations. You will be able to draw up ideas, plan and deliver programme sessions or activities. You will be resilient and comfortable adapting to different situations when delivering programme activities.

Nice to haves:

Previous experience of working at larger events and particularly in an administrative role will help. Connections with programme facilitators and ideas to enable delivery will be exceptionally useful.
